- Parking available across Baltimore Pike from Hosanna and Lincoln gate.

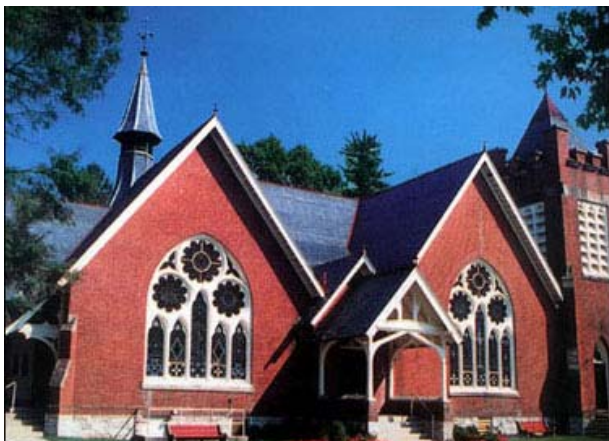


Hosanna AUMP Church (1843)
